in the City of Galveston



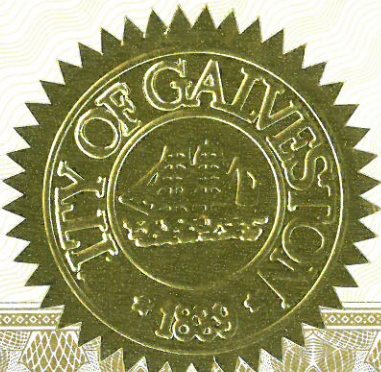


